

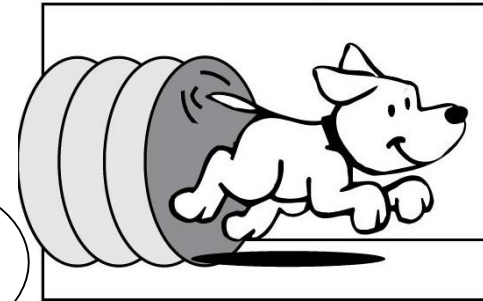

**MOVE UP REGULATIONS**

**Because this is a Novice-only trial, no move-ups are available after closing.**

**The only move-up available before closing is Novice A to Novice B.**

No changes are permitted after the closing date. A dog earning an agility title after the closing date is still eligible to run in Novice A, and is not permitted to move to Novice B after the closing date. Changes may be made before the closing date only; these include changes from Novice A to Novice B, changes from Regular to Preferred, and changes in jump height. All changes must be in writing. The form below may be used to make a change. All move-ups must be received by 6:00 p.m. Monday, November 9, 2009.

## ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and of AKC and that their dogs are familiar with and are able to perform all obstacles safely. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Proof of current vaccinations, including rabies, must be available at the trial if requested.

All dogs must be held on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or in the designated agility warm up area.

Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging. Exhibitors are responsible for being at ringside when it is their turn to run. Judges need not wait for dogs who are holding up the class.

An exercise area will be provided. All handlers must pick up after their dogs. Please don't allow dogs to use shrubbery or landscape trees to relieve themselves. **Anyone not cleaning up after their dogs or exercising their dogs in prohibited areas will be asked to leave.** In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

The Trial Giving Club assumes NO responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. Owners/handlers enter at their own risk and agree to assume responsibility for any damage caused by them, their dogs, or their children.

The club reserves the right to remove any animal in distress from a parked vehicle or crate, and all persons attending this agility trial hereby waive any claim for damages against the club for such removal.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from the competition by action of the Trial Committee, except that a refund of entry fees, minus \$6/run, for bitches in season will be made (a signed statement from a veterinarian must be received by the Trial Secretary on or before the day of the trial before judging starts). No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

**CLASSES OFFERED:** Standard (Novice A & B), Jumpers with Weaves (Novice A & B), FAST (Novice A & B), Standard Preferred (Novice), Jumpers with Weaves Preferred (Novice), FAST Preferred (Novice).

**CATALOGS:** Catalogs may be reserved for \$10 by checking the appropriate box on the entry form and including the catalog fee with your entry fees. A limited number will be available for purchase on the day of the trial. Running orders will be provided free to all exhibitors.

**OBSTACLES:** Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the regulations for AKC Agility Trials.

**FOOD:** There will **not** be food available for sale at the trial site.

**VENDORS:** Due to space considerations, we are not accepting vendors for this trial.

**CRATING:** Crating space is limited. Please stack crates, or crate out of your vehicle if possible. Unentered dogs must be left in your vehicle. **No** unentered dogs are permitted in the building.

**ELECTRONIC TIMING:** Electronic timing will be used at these trials.

**LIMITED PARKING:** There is limited parking available behind the WAG building (near the building entrance). Additional parking is available all around the building and on Industrial Court. Please don't park so that you block access to any of the large overhead doors, as some of our neighbors may need to receive shipments on the weekend.

**Each dog must be entered in ONLY Regular classes OR Preferred classes for the weekend. Each dog must be entered in only one height division for the weekend.**

## HEIGHT DIVISIONS

**Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division as shown in the table below.** Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division for regular classes ONLY, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in Preferred MUST run in their correct height division; they may not run at a higher or lower height. Dogs that run in a regular height division lower than their proper division or in a preferred height division at other than their proper division will be eliminated. **In no case may a dog be moved down in height after closing, whether due to an exhibitor entry error or due to a judge's measurement.** Dogs shall be moved down to the proper jump height if entered in the incorrect Preferred class jump height only if measured by a VMO, AKC Agility Field Rep, or Judge of Record. The secretary is not responsible for ensuring that a dog is entered in the proper height division. Any and all errors in height division entered are solely the responsibility of the exhibitor.

## DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC ILP/PAL number, or are eligible for entry in the Miscellaneous class, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Mixed breeds and breeds not registerable with the AKC are not eligible to enter. Refer to chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

## HEIGHT CARDS

The club will accept a photocopy of the entered dog's height card with each entry. However, exhibitors must have height cards available at the trial and be able to show them if asked. The secretary is not responsible for providing proof that a dog is in the correct height division. Otherwise, the dog's height must be checked either by presenting the AKC Height Card at check-in or by being measured by the judge of record (or a VMO if available) **prior to running the course.**

## COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND WARM-UPS

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk through period will be held prior to each class.

There will be no contact obstacle familiarization for novice dogs.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors. Exhibitors may not use the warm-up area to relieve their dogs. Consideration should be given to those teams who are due in the ring prior to other teams wishing to use the jump.

## PRIZES AND AWARDS

Dogs must qualify to receive awards. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Placement rosettes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place in each class in each height division. New title rosettes will be awarded to dogs completing an agility title at these trials. All prizes must be claimed at the trial, none will be mailed.

Online entries will **NOT** be accepted for these trials.

## DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE

### From the North:

Take Route 12 south (East Rt 12) to Spring Grove. Industrial Court is one block before Spring Grove Road and will be on the left side of the road.

### From the East:

Take Rt 173 West to Winn Road South to Rt 12 West. Industrial Court is one block West of Winn Road.

### From the West:

Take Rt 173 East to Route 12 South to Spring Grove. Industrial Court is one block before Spring Grove / Winn Roads.

### From the South:

Take Route 12 north (West Rt 12) to Spring Grove. Industrial Court is one block after Spring Grove / Winn Roads, and will be on the right side of the road.

Once you have turned onto Industrial Drive, take it to the second drive on the left (note: the first drive on the left is immediately after the turn onto Industrial so is easy to miss). Turn left and drive down the left side of the building and then to the right (around the side of the building) to the back of the building. The main entryway has an awning over it and is at the end of the parking lot, at the Northwest corner of the building, near where the dog potty area is located. You may park in any parking spaces in the industrial park, except do not block any of the overhead doors. Additional parking is available on Industrial drive (street parking).

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, and the FAST titling classes but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
