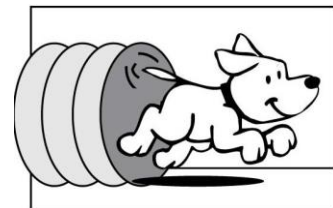


WI-IL Agility Club of Spring Grove, IL

AKC Agility Trial

August 21 - 23, 2020



Please carefully review your entry confirmation information and contact the trial secretary with any corrections by e-mail at wagakc_secretary@yahoo.com. Receipt of e-mails will be confirmed; if you don't get a reply to an e-mail, then I did not receive it.

Armbands: Arm Bands will not be utilized for this event. If you noted on your entry that your dog needs to be measured, your dog must be measured before you run. There WILL be a VMO in attendance on Friday only for this event.

Site Rules: Clean up after your dog, both at the site and at the hotels. Dogs are not permitted off leash outside the building. Please use the designated exercise area ONLY. Violators will be excused from the trial without refund.

Parking: There is parking around the sides and in back of the building. Parking at the back of the building near the door is reserved for people working (crating) out of their vehicles. If you park at one of these spots and are crating inside, you WILL be asked to move.

Crating: Crating areas will be marked. Crate in designated areas only. Please bring a mat or blanket to place under your crate to protect the floor.

The site will NOT be available for set up Thursday.

Food: Fast food is available nearby.

Workers: A worker schedule will be posted on the club website (wagagility.com). Check in with the ring captains well ahead of your worker assignment; this will make it easier for us to know of any gaps and fill them in time to keep an efficient trial. Unfortunately we will not be offering worker food, drinks, or snacks. Please bring your own snacks/lunch and water.

Directions to Trial:

The WAG Agility Building is located in Spring Grove, Illinois, on Route 12, just west of the intersection of Route 12 and Spring Grove/Winn Roads.

From the North:

Take Route 12 south (East Route 12) to Spring Grove. WAG is one block before Spring Grove Road and will be on the right side of the road.

From the South:

Take Route 12 north (West Route 12) to Spring Grove. WAG is one block after Spring Grove / Winn Roads, and will be on the left side of the road.

From the East:

Take Route 173 West to Winn Road South to Route 12 West. WAG is one block West of Winn Road.

From the West:

Take Route 173 East to Route 12 South to Spring Grove. WAG is one block before Spring Grove / Winn Roads.

SITE RULES

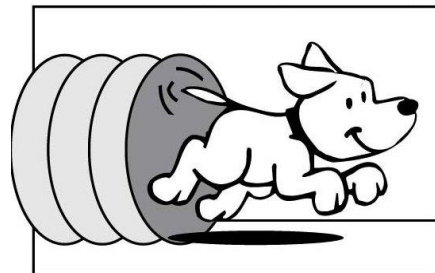
- If you are ill or have been in contact with someone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days (exception for front line workers with appropriate PPE) or if you or someone in your home has symptoms in the last 24 hours, PLEASE STAY HOME.
- Clubs, officials and participants are required to follow state, local and facility guidelines that apply to the area and site where the event is held. Since the trial is being held in Illinois, we will be following the executive order set forth by the Governor of Illinois.
- Practice social distancing consistent with current guidelines. Avoid congregating to the extent possible.
- Face masks are required while in public buildings and outside when social distancing is not possible. Face mask **must** be worn during your run. The mask **MUST** cover your face and nose. Face shields alone are not permitted (they have to be worn in conjunction with a mask).
- Hand sanitizer dispensers has been placed in strategic areas (by doors) for people to use and there is soap in restrooms.
- Wash hands as frequently as possible.
- High touch areas will be cleaned regularly.
- Avoid shaking hands or hugging.
- Avoid touching and giving treats to dogs that are not your responsibility.
- There will be no pens/pencils available for check in – bring your own. On Friday we will try using an electronic gate sheet. If it goes well, we will continue to use it on the weekend. Online running order for the current class running can be found at:

- We will be using REMIND to notify people what is happening in the trial. To sign up for REMIND notifications, text @WAGTRIALS to 81010 (81010 is the TO and the message is @WAGTRIALS). PLEASE NOTE texting rates apply. If you do not have a texting plan, you can download the REMIND app and sign up using the app instead. Use of REMIND is not necessary for this trial. Even if you signed up last time, you **WILL** have to sign up again. PLEASE Keep in mind that this is just a convenience and it “may” be possible that a walk through or dogs have started running remind message may be missed or not delivered to your phone.
- **Only** handlers entered in the event will be permitted in the building (Exception for Minors—a guardian is required).
- Crating will be allowed in the building, however people are urged to work from their vehicles. Minimum of 6’ distance will be required in crating areas and we will alternate large dog (20” – 24”) spot with small dog (16” – 4”). Large dog space will be marked with an L (on blue paper), Small dog with an S on yellow paper. If you own a Large and Small dog, just choose either space.
- No MACH/PACH cakes or shared food is permitted.
- No water will be available for your dog. PLEASE Bring your own water.

- There will be no general briefing. A preprinted briefing is attached to the end of this document. Briefings will not be held for Excellent/Master level classes.
- Walk-thru group sizes will be set at 25 handlers.
- A chute will be created for entering the ring and X's will be marked at 6' intervals for people waiting to enter the ring.
- PLEASE No congregating of people or dogs at the exit of the gate after your run. When you are done, please quickly move out of the area.
- Results will be posted in two places on the wall. We will also be posting these online as soon as a jump height/class is completed. QR codes will be posted in the building which can be scanned to access results on a smart phone. **Make sure your phone can access QR codes if you want to use this functionality OR bookmark the links provided in your final confirmation letter.**
- No printed copies of course maps will be provided. Maps will be posted in two places and will be available online. QR codes will be posted in the building which can be scanned to access course maps on a smart phone. **Make sure your phone can access QR codes if you want to use this functionality OR bookmark the links provided in your final confirmation letter.**

WORKERS

- It is recommend that ring crew use their own chairs. If not, then they will be wiped down between uses. Bar setter may choose to be given a zip lock bag with a sanitizing wipes to use that wipe in touching a bar or hand sanitizer (to be returned left at the chair position).
- Gate Steward will be provided at least a 6' buffer. PLEASE do not crowd the gate area.
- The trial secretary will be provided a 6' buffer. Please to not move inside of that space.
- Gate boards can be laid out before class for exhibitors to check in – but exhibitors **must** use their own pens.
- Leash Runner – Can either use then dispose of a paper towel to handle each leash, or can apply hand sanitizer between handling of each leash or use a “grabber”. If using a grabber, wipe down between leashes. Exhibitors are encouraged to place leashes in their pockets or wear them when running the course. Leash must fully fit in pocket.
- Course Builders –Do not share course maps with others. Hand sanitizer will be available for use after course building
- Timer/Scribe should sit at the ends of the table. Scribe should only use their pens. The table, timer console and chairs will be wiped down with each shift change.
- To minimize handling of scribe sheets, **only** the scribe and trial secretary will be permitted to touch them.
