

SETUP AGILITY

- Setup before the event includes:
 - **NOTE:** Renting club builds their own course on the turf ring.
 - Collect trash and empty all trash containers, replace plastic liner bags in cans and set all trash bags outside in WAG's waste receptacles.
 - Depending on which rings they have rented:
 1. Move equipment out of the blue mat ring, put out of the way either outside the blue barriers, in the obedience ring or at the back of the blue mat ring if there will be room.
 2. For AKC, move crates in the agility rings to obedience ring under the windows.
 3. For UKI and CPE, move crates in the agility rings to the back wall by the white cabinet that's next to the turf ring.
 4. Set up practice jump in obedience ring (SE corner) using tall gates from blue mat ring for AKC trials, use short gates from obedience ring for CPE & UKI.
 5. Put short gates up in blue mat ring towards the turf ring with openings for people to walk through.
 6. Put our club chairs along the above gates on the blue mats.
 7. Some clubs like crating space defined with aisles – talk to trial chair – they need to supply the 'tape.'
 - Put tables out for sec'y and timer/scribe, see if club wants one or more tables for ribbons or miscellaneous.

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- Set up one set of electronic timers. Use the one that has a note on it stating it works with the timer display.
- Plug in the timer display for testing. Be sure to unplug it before everyone leaves.
- Use table “D” and the legs specifically for this table. “D” legs will be together in one container. Make sure all correct sizes of legs needed for the trial are in the container. This is our trial-only table.
- Make sure teeter is set up correctly. Tray should be properly installed to hold the legs securely and two sandbags should be totally on the tray, one at either end (see teeter pic).
- Put out signs in parking lot to save spaces (ask club for specifics).
- They will set up kitchen how they want it.
- They will put out their own ribbons, although might need help.

NOTE: Keep track of weave poles connector piece so it isn't misplaced during the trial.
